Social Distancing

Guests must reasonably maintain a distance of 6 feet from other guests, excluding those within their household. This includes, but is not limited to: all entrances, lobbies, locker rooms, and the pool deck area.

Guests are encouraged to move through the facility in a timely manner, as to not spend unnecessary time loitering in the facility. Additionally, birthday parties or other social gatherings that utilize our side lobby (fish bowl) space are prohibited at this time.

Face Coverings

All guests over the age of 5 years old must wear a face mask or other face covering upon entering our facility. Face coverings must be worn from the time guests enter the facility until they have changed into their swimming attire and are on the pool deck, ready to enter the water.

Children under age 5 who are not wearing a mask should change in one of the private family rooms with a parent or guardian.

Hygiene Protocols

Guests are encouraged to use the available hand sanitizer located at both entrances before entering the facility. Frequent hand washing is also encouraged. Swimmers must also continue to follow our policy of showering before entering the water.

Sanitization

Locker rooms will be sanitized frequently depending on the patron load. Time between sanitization of the locker rooms will not exceed 60 minutes. All seating on the pool deck and in the lobbies will be sanitized every 60 minutes, or more frequently as needed.

Toys and exercise equipment will be sanitized by the staff after each use. Toys and equipment in need of cleaning will be clearly separated from the sanitized equipment. Guests are encouraged to take advantage of the sanitizing properties of the pool water by fully submerging clean borrowed equipment for a few seconds before use.

High traffic items (railings, door handles, etc) will be sanitized as needed, with the time between cleaning not to exceed 60 minutes.

*** Pool Layout**

The main pool will be separated into sections consisting of 4 lap lanes, 1 double wide lane, a diving well aqua-jogging space, and a space for diving board activities.

The whirlpool and wading pool will not be open at this time.

Patrons within the same family may share a lane or a space closer than 6 feet apart. Those not in the same family or household must reasonably attempt to maintain 6 foot distances from other patrons.

Patron Load + Time Limits

A limit of 20 patrons at one time will be in place. Time limits of 60 minutes will be enforced. If there are no other patrons waiting for entry, guests may extend their time.

Guests may sign up for a time slot if it is known in advance by calling the facility and speaking to a staff member or leaving a voice message with their name, phone number, and time requested.

Guests may not sign up for back-to-back slots at this time, but may extend their time if there are no patrons waiting.

Locker Room Procedure

Lockers will be unavailable at this time. Swimmers are encouraged to bring a duffle bag or equivalent to store their items on the pool deck. Plastic tote bins will be available to transport personal items to the pool deck area if a swimmer does not have a bag large enough for this purpose. Personal items must be brought to the pool deck and may not be left in the locker rooms.
